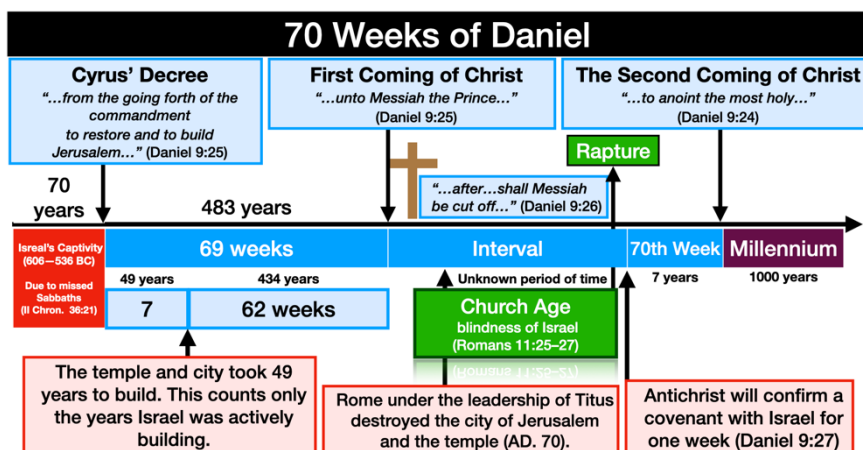


The Rapture of the Church

(I Thessalonians 4:13–18)

Although The word rapture is not found in the Scripture, it is commonly used in reference to the phrase in I Thessalonians 4:17, “caught up.” This phrase is translated from the Greek word *harpázō*, which means, “To seize upon, spoil, snatch away.” When we refer to the rapture of the church, we are referring to a time when Jesus Christ comes back to “snatch up” those in Christ, marking the end of the church age. The Old Testament saints will be resurrected at the end of the Great Tribulation (Dan. 12:1–3).

- I. The church age is a period of _____ duration that occurs before the Tribulation week or also known as the Seventieth Week of Daniel’s prophecy (Dan. 9:24–27).



- A. A week is a period divided into _____, whether that be seven days or seven years. 70 weeks equals 490 years (70 X 7).
- B. This 70-week period was a time where _____ would be under gentile dominion known as the “times of the gentiles.” (Luke 21:24).

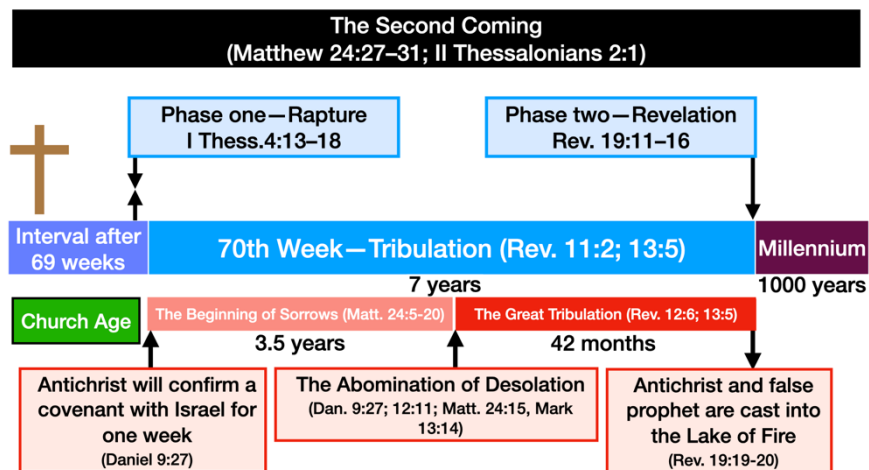
1. The first period of 49 years (7 weeks) is from Cyrus' decree for Israel to return to Israel from Babylon to when Nehemiah completed the wall around Jerusalem (Isa. 44:28-45:4; Dan. 9:25).
2. The second period of 434 years (62 weeks) was from the completion of the walls of Jerusalem to the birth of Jesus Christ the Messiah (Daniel 9:25).
3. The Lord placed an interval before the 70th week, where Messiah the prince would be cut off (Isa. 53:8; I Jo. 2:2). God chose the church to carry on the plan of reaching the world with the Gospel until the fulness of the Gentiles is come in (Rom. 11:12–26).
4. The 70th week will begin with the antichrist signing a covenant with Israel for 7 years (Dan. 9:27).

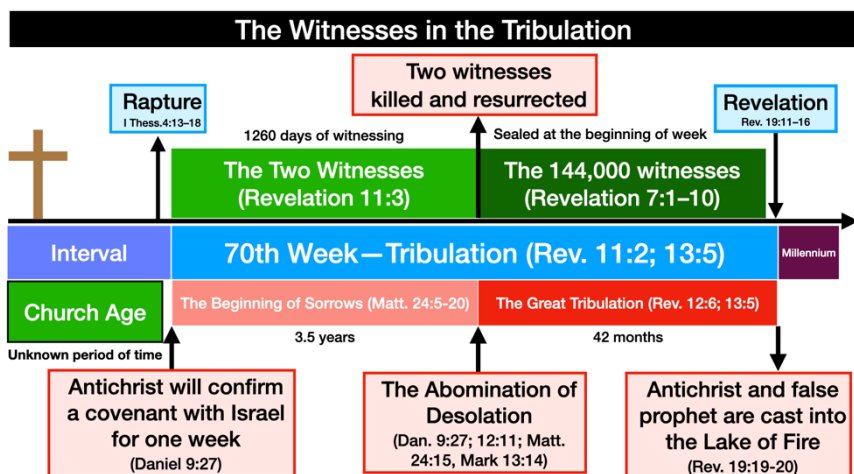
